
















# HULU LANGAT WOMEN SOCIAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP PROGRAMME

• Shapes the society and culture in most villages i.e. "kampong".






- HL CC is a public institution established in 2003 under the purview of Ministry Of Higher Education





Working Together towards Harmonisation and Internationalistion

#### **Objectives and Principles**


