MONEY

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

INDIGENOUS PROGRAMS OPERATE FROM THE OUTREACH PROGRAMS DEPARTMENT STAFFED BY 3 INDIGENOUS AND 3 NON-INDIGENOUS STAFF. (PROGRAM COORDINATOR, PROGRAM ADMINISTRATOR, LLN SPECIALIST, DRIVING INSTRUCTORS X 2)

DEPARTMENT HAS BEEN OPERATING FOR 8 YEARS

ABORIGINAL SUB-COMMITTEE MEETS AT LEAST 3 TIMES EACH YEAR TO PROVIDE GUIDANCE AND INPUT INTO PROGRAMS AND HAS FOUR MEMBERS

ASSIST WITH BUILDING GENERAL ACE STAFF CULTURAL CAPABILITY

DEVELOPED ACE INDIGENOUS ENGAGEMENT STRATEGY TO GUIDE OUR BUSINESS OPERATIONS

OUTSOURCED SUB-CONTRACTING – WHERE POSSIBLE ASSIST ABORIGINAL BUSINESSES

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ACE INDIGENOUS PROGRAMS CAN BE CLASSIFIED AS

MAINSTREAM COURSES DELIVERED TO INDIGENOUS PEOPLE IN RESPONSE TO SPECIFIC REQUESTS OR NEEDS

- Request from Bunjum Aboriginal Corporation to help them achieve the aim to have an all Indigenous staff for their Early Childhood Centre by offering a Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care Aboriginal people selected by Bunjum and ACE
- Request from Jubal Corporation for a Certificate IV in Business Administration program for selected leaders in the community

MAINSTREAM COURSES THAT HAVE BEEN DESIGNED TO BE INCLUSIVE OF ABORIGINAL CULTURAL PERSPECTIVES

- Certificate II in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Cultural Art
- Accredited skills sets including a program for the Githabul Rangers and for the Evans Heads Rangers

COURSES THAT HAVE BEEN SPECIFICALLY DESIGNED FOR INDIGENOUS PEOPLE

- Certificate II in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Cultural Art
- Bundjalung language classes at Balund-a and Casino.

- AS PART OF OUR INDIGENOUS ADVANCEMENT STRATEGY FUNDING WE ARE COMMITTED TO RAISING THE QUALIFICATION LEVELS FOR INDIGENOUS STUDENTS TO CERTIFICATE III AND ABOVE IN ORDER TO INCREASE JOB OUTCOMES.
- ACE IS SPECIFICALLY DESIGNING PROGRAMS TO INCLUDE PROGRESSIONS FROM LOWER LEVEL QUALIFICATIONS TO THOSE TARGETED AT CERTIFICATE III AND ABOVE.




PROTOCOLS:

ACE Colleges have worked in the Aboriginal education space since the late 1990's. We have successfully offered training to members of Aboriginal Communities working in partnerships with Aboriginal Corporations and Local Land Councils in rural and remote locations.

There are keys factors which make the projects successful:

- 1. The importance of creating enduring partnerships with Aboriginal people built on trust and mutual respect.
- 2. Engagement and consultation prior to arranging & providing appropriate training
- 3. Partnering with Aboriginal corporations and communities to encourage ownership and control over the decision making during the establishment of the programs requested.
- 4. Training to be offered in a culturally appropriate location to ensure the students feel safe and comfortable.
- 5. Flexibility is significant in order to accommodate cultural aspects of sorry business and family demands, which can impact on attendance and successful outcomes of the program.

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
