WHAT PARTICULAR ACHIEVEMENTS OF YOUR

SINCE 2008 WE AT SCC HAVE ENROLLED OVER 120,000 STUDENTS;

WE HAVE CONDUCTED OVER 15,000 WORKSHOPS OR CLASSES;

IT'S IMPORTANT TO NOTE THAT LESS THAN 15% OF THAT EFFORT HAS BEEN IN GOVERNMENT FUNDED VET;

IMPORTANTLY, WE'VE STAYED OPEN DURING SOME TUMULTUOUS CHANGES INCLUDING THE LOSS OF GOVERNMENT FUNDING, THE GFC AND CONTINUING FINANCIAL STRESS.

WE DID THAT BY MOVING EARLY TO THE DIGITAL WORLD SUCH AS WEBSITE DESIGN, EMAIL CAMPAIGNS, SOCIAL MEDIA MARKETING AND SEO EXPERTISE

BY BECOMING AND REMAINING AGILE,

BY BECOMING AND REMAINING DEMAND DRIVEN.

BY BECOMING AND REMAINING STUDENT FOCUSSED.

WHAT DO YOU SEE AS THE BIGGEST CHALLENGES
FOR AUSTRALIAN POST-SECONDARY EDUCATION
RIGHT NOW?

TO ME, THERE IS A RISK THAT SINCE THE EARLY 2000'S WE HAVE BEGUN TO VIEW EDUCATION AS BEING MORE ABOUT MEASUREMENT AND STANDARDS AND LESS ABOUT LEARNING.

MY VIEW IS THAT LIFE-LONG LEARNING AS A PRINCIPLE IS BEING LOST IN AUSTRALIA AND THE VET AGENDA IS TOO STRONGLY DOMINATING POLICY THINKING AND FUNDING INITIATIVES.

WHILE I BELIEVE VET TO BE IMPORTANT, WITHIN THE EDUCATION LANDSCAPE, IT MAKES UP ONLY PART OF THE WHOLE PICTURE.

IT IS IMPORTANT TO RECOGNISE THAT THE DISCOURSE WE HAVE ABOUT EDUCATION, ABOUT LEARNING AND ITS VALUE, DOES NOT DEVALUE ANY THAT IS NOT QUALIFICATION FOCUSSED.

I BELIEVE THAT WE MUST REMEMBER THAT EDUCATION IS A SOCIAL GOOD AND WE ARE AT SOME RISK OF LOOSING THAT PERSPECTIVE.
