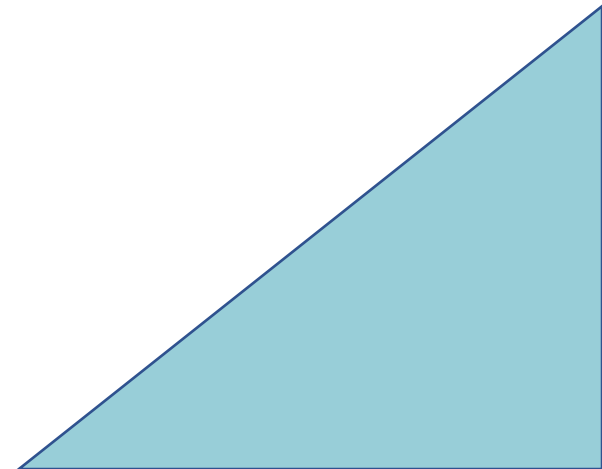
# Disability Standards in Education review 2020

- expanding Exemplars of Practice to be reviewed and expanded (Recommendation 4)
- ensure national alignment of relevant education policies and regulations with the DSE including the Standards for Registered Training Organisations (RTO), Standards for VET Accredited Courses, Standards for VET Training Package and Standards for VET Regulators (Recommendation 7)
- Australian Government Minister for Skills to work together with State/Territory Skills Ministers to identify opportunities to strengthen delivery of VET for students (Recommendation 9).



# Supporting Students with Disability in VET project

- develop resources to build Registered Training Organisation (RTO) capability to support students with disability
- develop resources for course designers to support removing unnecessary barriers within training packages and accredited courses for students with disability
- review enrolment practices for students with disability.

A range of customisable and downloadable templates and examples to illustrate how you can evidence your practice in supporting students with disability in VET.

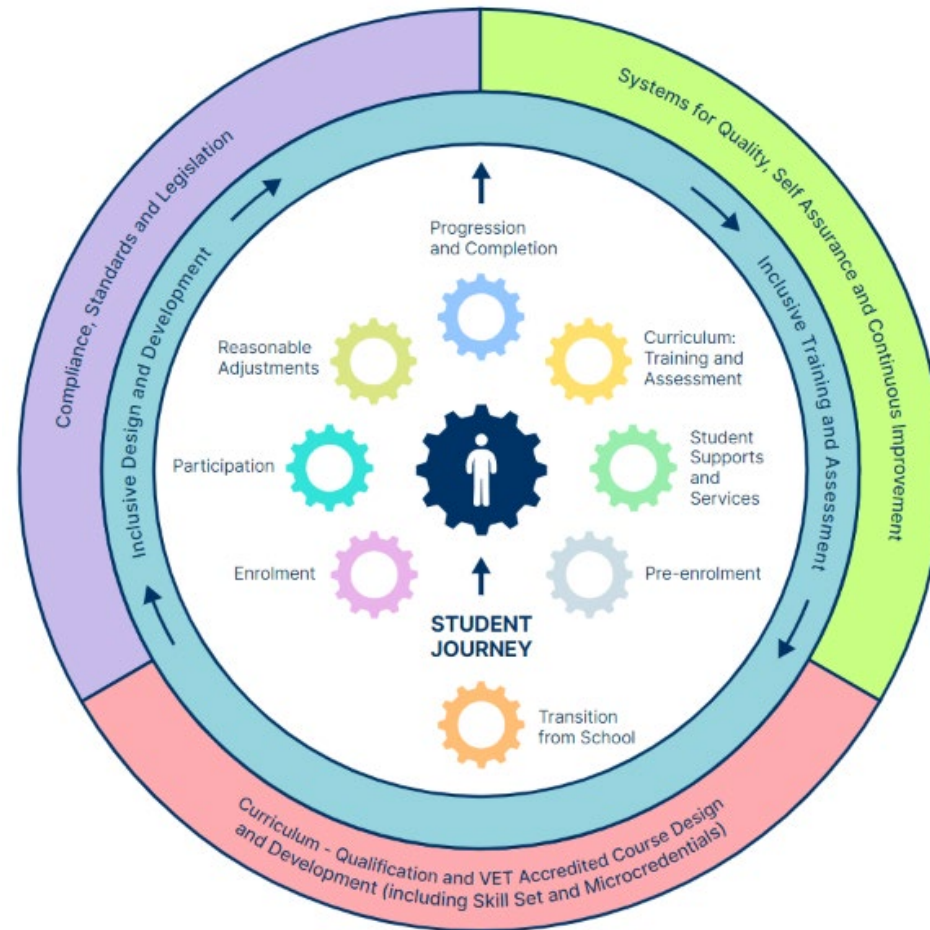


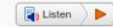
