










Learners have read-only access to their certified credentials, to view and share as they need



Evaluation of QUANTITATIVE targets

| Target (Quantitative) | Actual |

| \$13.4 million savings in first 3 years of full operations (replacing hard-copy with digital) | \$20.8 million savings realised in the first 3 years of operation (2019-21) |
| \$10.4M reduction in fee revenues for document issuance in first 3 years of full operations (due to expected reduced demand for hardcopy and lower fee for digital) | Revenues increased (in one case by 140+%) due to increased demand and actual institutional fee models. |
| \$3.0 million net benefit in first 3 years of full operation | Estimated \$30 million+ net benefit in first 3 years of full operation |

You will be notified via your personal email when your documents are ready, with a link to create your My eQuals account.



My eQuals protects your qualifications, guaranteeing the integrity and authenticity of your digital documents. Your official academic documents are provided in high definition, as they appear on paper, accessible anytime and anywhere.

When you complete your course you will receive a text message from Wodonga TAFE followed by an email from My eQuals regarding your documents.

If you have an existing My eQuals account, use this account to log in and access your documents.

If you do not have a My eQuals account, follow the instructions in the email from My eQuals to create your account to access your documents.

What you will receive

Following completion of your course with Wodonga TAFE, you will be automatically issued digital academic documents through the My eQuals portal.
